*Major Activities Descriptions:

Outreach Ministry to the Homeless and Hungry:

- Monthly Food Drive –Collect non-perishable food, hygiene and toiletry donations, the first Sunday of each month and deliver to a local food Pantry.
- Monthly Meals Preparation Help prepare and deliver lunches for those in need.
- Winter Warmth Giveaway Collect and sort clothing donations for those in need. Volunteers can also participate in the annual one-day event to provide warm winter clothing and serve hot food to our local neighbors in need.

Golden Age Christmas Luncheon (early December)

Philoptochos hosts a festive holiday luncheon for parish seniors.

• From September through April/May on the third Thursday of the month, we host a monthly event including a speaker or film and lunch for approximately 75 attendees in the Frosene Center Ballroom. Philoptochos sets the tables, serves the food, and is responsible for the cleanup.

Lenten Retreat (Kathara Deftera, 1st Day of Lent)

- Help set up, prepare, and serve a Lenten lunch immediately following the annual Lenten Retreat.
- Held in FJ Hall, the Retreat features either a guest speaker or a question and answer session with Father Steve and Father Panayiotis.

Preparing Palm Crosses & Flowers for Epitaphio

During Lent, we strip palms and make them into palm crosses for the priests to distribute to parishioners on Palm Sunday. On Holy Thursday, we prepare the flowers that will decorate the Epitaphio.

Outreach to Parishioners

- Accompany parish priests on Christmas and Easter pastoral visits.
- Sunshine Committee send personal greetings to members to acknowledge milestones and important events.

Fundraising Activities – Examples from past years include:

- Sale of items such as: Our Community Cookbook, Aprons, Mugs and Christmas Ornaments.
- In addition to our stewardship funds, we raise donations for Charitable Causes as they occur during the year, including natural disasters, as well as our designated Christmas Charities.

Clothing/Book Drives

- Collect clothing for the Winter Warmth Giveaway and Partners for Kids in Care program for DC Foster children.
- Book drive for Reading Partners' of DC, a reading program for grades K-4 students in Washington DC public schools.

Meeting Programs & Outings

Help plan speakers and special events for our General Membership Meetings. Organize field trips to local DMV points of interest.
