It is important that we acknowledge the generosity of donors who make gifts and commitments to the Saint Sophia Cathedral Narthex Campaign. Accordingly, a Wall of Honor will be placed prominently in a future New Visitor Center to recognize those in our community who contribute gifts or fulfill pledges of \$5,000 or more.
