Sunday School Location and Times:

All Sunday School classes are held on the **second floor of the Frosene Center**, connected to Saint Sophia. You can access the classrooms via the Frosene Center elevators or by walking through Father John Hall and the atrium—classrooms are down the hall on the left.

Arrival:

Please bring your children to church and have them sit with the Sunday School teachers in the **reserved pews on the left side** of the nave. The **Divine Liturgy begins at 10:00 AM**—we ask families to **arrive by 10:30 AM**.

Class Time:

Sunday School begins **immediately after communion**. Teachers will walk the children from the pews to their classrooms. Drop-off is also available—please ensure your child is registered and we have your contact information.

Dismissal:

Classes end at 12:00 PM.

- **6th grade and younger**: Parents must pick up children directly from their classrooms after liturgy.
- 7th grade and up: Students will be dismissed at noon and may join their families at coffee hour in Father John Hall.

Talks with Our Clergy:

We are honored to have a series of three different sessions where our clergy share wonderful, age-appropriate lessons with our Sunday School students.

Holy Communion:

Per Father Steve, "make an effort to limit food immediately before communion or if your child needs food but feed them but keep the meal light (skip the bacon, eat the toast)."
